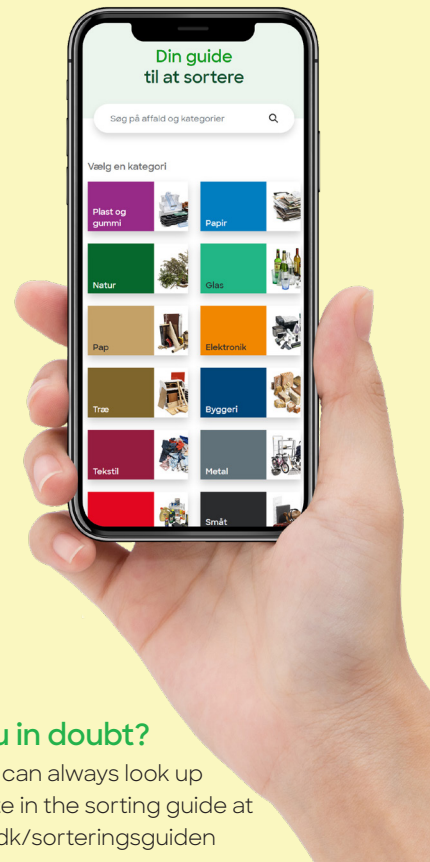

You can hand in any clothing, furniture and other items that are still in such good condition that other people could still enjoy them at your local charity shop or at one of the clothing deposit stations that have been set up at various locations. You can also hand items in for reuse at all the recycling stations in Aarhus.
